- Confirmation of corporate membership will be given by English UK and will be made definitive by issuance of confirmation letter and receipt of payment.
- Corporate membership will be annual (January-December) and payment will run pro-rata, depending on the date of commencement, based on full months of membership in the first year of joining.
- An organisation may withdraw from corporate membership by giving two weeks' notice in writing to English UK but no refunds on subscriptions will be made whatever the date of withdrawal.
