Why attend this training day?

Safeguarding is constantly evolving. Changes and improvements happen frequently and designated safeguarding staff in ELT organisations need to keep on top of these updates. They also need to refresh their knowledge every two years. This training is prepared specially for designated staff in ELT organisations. As a refresher/review session, trainees should be prepared to bring their own knowledge and experiences of safeguarding to the table. The session will also include a case study from the ELT industry, allowing participants to learn from real events and any recent updates.

The new Accreditation UK handbook, covering inspections 2018-19 is due for release in Autumn 2017. Sessions occurring after its release will include discussion and explanation of any changes affecting safeguarding. Through shared experiences and updated information, trainees should return from the session confident in their abilities to support high safeguarding standards in their organisations.

Safeguarding legislation and terminology differs in each of the countries of the UK (England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland). The focus of the training will be on legislation and terminology in England. Delegates from Scotland are advised that safeguarding provision there differs substantially and separate training is available from English UK.
