

Proposed membership fees for 2026

The English UK membership fee has two components: a basic and a supplementary subscription. The total fee depends on the size of each member's teaching operation, based on [student weeks](#).

Part-time student weeks are included in the fees. 'Part-time' students have less than 10 hours of ELT tuition in a week. They will be treated as 0.5 student weeks.

Basic subscriptions

The proposed basic subscription fee for 2026 is £1,754.

Very small centres will pay a reduced rate (see table below).

Supplementary subscriptions

Members pay a supplementary subscription fee, based on the size of their English language teaching centre operation. Your band for 2026 will be confirmed after you have submitted your 2025 student data.

Group subscriptions

Groups of accredited centres in the same ownership receive one combined invoice for the group's basic subscription and one for the group's combined supplementary subscription. The group pays:

- £1,754 (£1,690 in 2025) for the first centre
- £1,578 (£1,520 in 2025) for each additional centre (eg £3,332 for a group of two centres)
- Plus a supplementary subscription fee based on the total of the student weeks taught by all centres in the group (see bands above).
