## Student weeks and how to calculate

We use student weeks to measure the business size of English language teaching (ELT) centres.

When we talk about student weeks, we only include English language courses accredited by the British Council.

## Full-time and part-time student weeks

- A full-time student week represents one student who has 10 or more teaching contact hours in one week.
- A part-time student week represents one student who has less than 10 teaching contact hours in one week.
- 1 contact hour is 60 minutes.


## Students who take multiple courses

If a student enrolls on more than one course at the same time they should only be counted once.

## Calculation examples

| Examples | No. of <br> students | ELT contact <br> hours per <br> week | Course <br> length | Calculation | Total student <br> weeks |
| :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: |
| Full-time <br> students | 10 | 15 hours | 8 weeks | $10 \times 8$ | 80 <br> full-time weeks |
| Students on <br> multiple <br> courses | 12 | $15+10$ <br> hours <br> $(25$ hours) | 2 weeks | $12 \times 2$ | 24 <br> full-time weeks |
| Part-time <br> students | 5 | 7 hours | 3 weeks | $5 \times 3$ | 15 <br> part-time <br> weeks |
