World Geography (20 points)

- 1. Which country has the longest coastline? (Canada)
- 2. Which is the largest country in the European Union by area? (France)
- 3. Which country has the most land borders with other countries? (China 16)
- 4. There are three countries with dragons on their flags can you name any? (1 point each)
 - a. Wales
 - b. Bhutan
 - c. Malta (you need to look closely in the top left!)
- 5. I am walking in a jungle and I see a jaguar which continent am I on? (South / Central America*)
- Let's travel the world! For the super pedants the rules for these questions are the
 directions are <u>cardinal</u>: they are based on latitude and longitude lines on the globe (show a
 globe if poss). They are NOT based on magnetic compass directions (which fluctuate) OR
 flat map projections which can distort. (<u>1 point each</u>)

 - f. Now I'm in a rowing boat in Land's End (far western point of England) and I row South. What is the first country I reach? (Spain)

- 8. What is the highest mountain in the world (English name)? Everest

- 16. Which traditional English sport involves these things ball, bats, pads, stumps, bails and a wicket? (Cricket)

World - General knowledge (10 points)

- 1. Where was Ghengis / Chingis Khan almost certainly born (name of the country which now exists in that area)? (Mongolia)
- 2. Which multi-award winning female artist was a member of the girl group Destiny's Child? (Beyoncé)
- 3. What does 'Nike' (the sports clothing brand) mean? (Nike is the name of the Greek Goddess of victory the Romans called her 'Victoria')
- Which country has won the most medals at Olympic Summer Games*? (United States of America – interesting aside, second is still the Soviet Union which collapsed in 1991 – NOT Russia, which is 10th.
- 5. Fiji has won one Olympic Gold medal, in 2016. Which team sport did they win? (Rugby 7s accept rugby!)
- 6. What is the largest animal in the world (English name)? (Blue whale / Balaenoptera musculu)
- 7. Which Italian astronomer first observed moons orbiting around Jupiter?** (Galileo Galilei)
- 8. Which pop group had hits with Waterloo, The Winner Takes it All and Mamma Mia, and which country do they come from? (1 point each)
 - a. (Abba)
 - b. (Sweden)
- 9. Raisins, currants and sultanas are food made of dried ...what? (grapes).
