UK ELT: before the pandemic

- The UK attracted 550,000 ELT students annually
- Around half from Europe and in 2019 over half (54%) of those were juniors (under-18 years old)
- According to VisitBritain research UK ELT students spend twice as much money in the UK and stay three times as long as other inbound travellers.



Impact of the pandemic

Data from our annual reports showed:

- 2020 saw 84% drop in UK ELT student numbers
- Impact on student numbers deepened in 2021
- 2019 v 2021 year-on-year UK decline worse than global ELT average
- 2019 v 2021: -88% student numbers, -71% student weeks
- 40 teaching premises permanently closed
- BUT 85% of English UK member centres have survived



Recovery in Q1 & Q2 2022

Data from our quarterly reports showed:

- Q1 2022 (January March):
 172% increase in student weeks on Q1 2021 (~55% recovery on pre-pandemic volume).
- Q2 2022 (April June):
 181% increase in student weeks on Q2 2021 (~70% recovery on pre-pandemic volume)
- But recovery continued at a slower pace for the junior segment
- The top ranked source markets largely reflected pre-Covid Q2 ones, with China and Russia the notable absences



Our latest statistics: Q3 2022

- Summer rebound seen for both adult and junior segments
- Juniors up a massive 3,254% compared with Q3 2021 (after having dwindled to almost nothing during the pandemic)
- Overall student weeks reached 55% of the level seen in summer 2019

Note: The figures relate to a like-to-like comparison, which is based on data from centres reporting in both Q3 2021 and Q3 2022 (n=119 centres).

Top 5 junior source:


 Italy (29.5%), Spain (11.2%), France (6.5%) Germany (6.4%) & Brazil (6.1%)

Top 5 adult source markets:

Saudi Arabia (17.9%), China (8.2%), Italy (7.4%),
 Brazil 7.3%) & Japan (5.5%)



Q3 2022: overall top markets and student weeks (with age group breakdown)






Q3 2022: market structure & dynamics similar to pre-pandemic levels

Market dynamics and outlook

Recovery drivers

- UK position v competitor ELT destinations (rival MESDs)
- Pent-up demand
- Further easing of Covid-related restrictions in source markets (China)
- Visa free travel extensions (Saudi, Colombia, Peru)
- Demand for UK HE
- Blended/ online course delivery
- Relatively weak GBP

Barriers to recovery

- UK position v rival MESDs!
- Capacity shortages staff and accommodation
- Impact of Brexit
- Government policies eg. absence of work rights
- Flight availability
- Cost of living crisis



UK Quality Assurance Framework

An education sector wide initiative



- Jointly led by the British Council, BUILA, UKCISA and UUKI.
- Based on recommendations from extensive research with students, education providers, education advisers and agents.
- The framework is designed to enhance the partnership between the UK education sector and agents and counsellors and to recognise and share best practice.

The framework's seven tools

- 1. UK agent engagement hub
- 2. Agent training
- 3. National code of ethical practice for education agents
- 4. Good practice **guide for agents** partnering with UK provider
- 5. A database of certified agents and councillors
- 6. The **student guide** to choosing an agent
- 7. Good practice **guide for providers** using agents
